Ten Al Governance Practices Every Board Should Adopt

As Al becomes embedded in core business functions, effective governance is critical. Here is a practical checklist for board directors to ensure responsible, strategic Al adoption.

- 1. Establish Al literacy training for all board members.
- 2. Appoint a dedicated AI ethics or technology risk committee.
- 3. Integrate AI risk and impact assessments into standard board reporting.
- 4. Review and approve an organisation-wide Al governance framework.
- 5. Ensure transparency and auditability of critical Al systems.
- 6. Mandate regular bias testing and fairness reviews for deployed Al tools.
- 7. Oversee Al use in workforce planning, including reskilling strategies.
- 8. Require alignment of Al applications with corporate values and ESG goals.
- 9. Develop protocols for Al-related crisis response and accountability.
- 10. Ensure clear communication of Al practices to stakeholders, including investors and regulators.
